

ERASMUS+ MOBILITY

Erasmus+ is the largest programme of the European Union dedicated to the development of education, through the financing of projects, partnerships and credit mobility in the period 2014 – 2020. Credit mobility («exchange») belongs to the first segment of the Erasmus+ programme entitled Key Action 1. Universities in the Republic of Serbia got the opportunity to participate in this part of the Programme in the academic 2015/2016.

In 2015, the overall budget for Key Action 1 for the region of the Western Balkans, for mobility of students, teachers and administrative staff, between the countries of the Western Balkans and the EU, was 22.4 million euros, and the estimated number of Erasmus+ grants for incoming and outgoing mobility was around 3,600.

The Programme enables mobility of students at all levels of study and in all disciplines. The duration of student mobility ranges between 3 to 12 months. The duration of staff mobility, for the purpose of teaching or training, can be between 5 days and 2 months.

Student grants that are available for students from the Republic of Serbia who go on mobility are between 750 and 850 euros per month. The monthly grant for Erasmus+ foreign students in Serbia is 650 euros.

The University of Novi Sad actively participates in the Erasmus+ programme of credit mobility, which is illustrated by the results achieved in the academic 2015/2016.
