A Trip to Experience Traditional China and Shanghai Style Culture

Introduction

This program was initiated by the Shanghai Government to promote mutual cultural exchanges among "The Belt and Road" countries. The applicant shall also be aged from 24 to 50 and in good health, abide by the laws of the People's Republic of China and the rules and regulations of the university.
